Booth space will be limited for this event. Potential vendors please submit an application, along with a photo of your booth and your booth space fee of \$40.00. Booth space will be 10' x 10', without electricity. Submissions will be juried and accepted entries will be contacted. We would like to accept all entries, but with limited space we will try to accept a mix of various mediums. All work must be original and handcrafted.

Set up will begin at 2:00 pm on Friday, September 18. Please note: Road access is limited on Saturday morning. All booths will be on the grass. No vehicles will be allowed on the grass - please bring a hand truck if needed. Exhibitors will provide their own display stands and should plan for protective coverings if desired. This event will be held rain or shine. Liability insurance is the sole responsibility of the artist/crafter.

Entry fees will be returned if the exhibitor is not accepted. Please make your check payable to: Cromaine District Library. There are no refunds after acceptance.
